



Health Fair Presentation

Tennessee is experiencing rapid growth in its older adult population, with more than 1.22 million residents aged 65 and older. Many rural counties are aging at the fastest rates, and older adults are projected to outnumber children in the coming years. Falls remain the leading cause of injury-related hospitalization and death among older adults, and Tennessee's aging housing stock, limited accessibility features, and high rates of chronic conditions increase risk. Area communities will benefit from the reduction in stress placed on area healthcare resources.

95% of adults 55+ consider aging in place a personal priority.

More than 80% of older adults report feeling safest and most comfortable in their own homes.

In Tennessee—there are 1,220,972 residents age 65+ as of 2022.

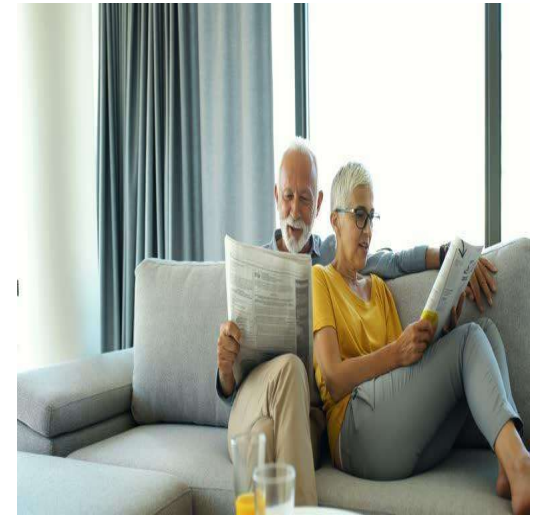

Our Strategic Priorities

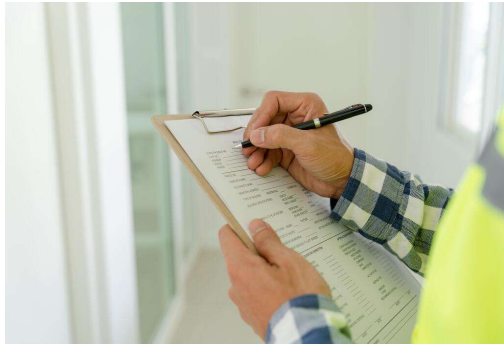
To: Serve those over age 60 through programs and activities, with a special emphasis on maintaining health, transportation and safety.

Our Products and Services

We are taking two linked approaches to accomplishing our mission.

Program 1 is to provide support to individuals in the identification of possible safety barriers in their place of residence, which could result in accidents or injuries and their not being able to stay at home. This will be addressed by providing a variety of helpful information, at no cost to the senior, thorough workshops, web based toolbox and access to a certified inspector if needed to ensure a safe environment. We will provide homeowners a list of potential vendors to choose from, who make necessary safety corrections and guidance on selecting qualified help in making any safety corrections.

Program 2 Community Education

This is a comprehensive public education initiative designed to increase awareness, shift attitudes, and empower families, seniors, and community partners to support aging in place. Its purpose is to educate the public and community leaders about the benefits of aging in place, while promoting the services that make that possible.

We will reach out to the community and provide focused workshops for Seniors utilizing area Senior Centers, faith based organizations and public events such as health fairs. We also have a web based toolbok that links individuals with information and resources which can assist them in learning about maintaining a safe home enviroment and finding ressources to assist them.
